Brooklyn Improvement Master Plan

3.18pm – Vice-President Di Bowles introduced Ward A Councillor Nathan Tilbury, who led a discussion regarding the process for development of the Brooklyn Master Plan, with particular focus on the process to establish a reference group and steering group. Questions were taken from the floor.

Cr Tilbury read out the process for early steps in the Brooklyn Master Plan including application for the Community Reference Group. He invited applications for inclusion in the reference group from any individual or group confirming that the process was open to all.

Di Bowles stated that the BCA thought the CRG selection process needed to be more transparent. The BCA is concerned that there is fair representation in the CRG. Cr Tilbury stated that they did not have a number of people or selection criteria but he assumed he would be helping to select the group members.
