Status of the Master Plan

At the General Meeting on 12 August 2015, Council authorised the General Manager to finalise specifications and proceed to tender to develop a Master Plan for Brooklyn. We understand that the development of the Master Plan will likely occur during calendar year 2016.

The development of the Master Plan will be directed by a Project Control Group of Council officers, the consultant, the Mayor and three Councillors, and community involvement will take place through a Community Reference Group.

Most local residents will have received a request from Council seeking expressions of interest from groups and organisations to be represented on the Community Reference Group, and nominations close on Friday 16 October.

The Brooklyn Community Association will be nominating representatives to participate in the Community Reference Group. We recommend that other Brooklyn and Lower Hawkesbury groups and organisations should nominate to participate in the CRG, to ensure the Master Plan meets all our needs.

The Brooklyn Community Association is hosting a General Community Meeting for the Brooklyn and Lower Hawkesbury Community to update the community on the Brooklyn Improvement Masterplan. Ward A Councillors will attend the meeting and will present Council's plans and answer community questions on the Masterplan and the role of the Community Reference Group.
